Dear President Clinton

Thank you for granting us the opportunity to discuss our initiatives for Haiti. You certainly have inspired me by your visible concern and desire to overcome some of the numerous socioeconomic, cultural and political hurdles to provide sustainable models of infrastructure development in the country.

I wish to present to you the Pinnacle Healthcare Consortium (PHC), of which I take an active role in the corporate governance of its senior management team. PHC is comprised of a group of International Development Practitioners who have a proven track record implementing a wide range of infrastructure improvement programs in developing countries. We all appreciate that sustained pressure will be required from a wide range of sources to give the Haitians a glimmer of hope in receiving some of the life chances that many of us take for granted.

7. Sustainable renewable energy; initially for the clinics
8. Healthcare IT (enabling international financial remittances to support the system)

An integrated program that will not only build the human capacity for the Haitians to manage these programs, but will also create economic growth opportunities for the Haitian government and selected US corporate entities.
